

2021 WOBA FOOD STOPS

Here are the official food stops on the WOBA routes, plus several FOYO (food on your own locations. All official stops will have free tap water and portable toilets. The FOYO stops typically are businesses that have a restroom and sell snacks, water and other drinks.
